T1 - Oak - Crown clean. End weight reduction of limbs by approximately 2.5 meters on North West side of the tree to reduce loading on damaged union.
T2 - Cedar - Felled just above ground level due to co-dominant stem and included union causing vertical fracture.
T3 - Pine - Fell to ground level. Remove due to proximity to garage.
T4 - Chestnut - Fell to ground level due to advanced infection from Phytothora causing significant decay.
T5 - Small Oak - Fell to ground level due to suppression from neighbouring trees.
T6 - Pine - Fell to ground level due to poor specimen and poor form
T7 - Pine - Fell to ground level due to poor specimen and poor form
